Do not forget that Supreme Per Capitas are due NOW. Councils will be suspended on April 10 for non-payment, so please get these paid. Contact your DD if you are not able to go online and see your council statement.

Also, State Per Capitas, if not yet paid, were due March 1. If they have not been paid, your council cannot participate in any State Council activities. These include State Free Throw Contest, Educational Grants, State Program Awards, State Convention, and so on. Please pay State Per Caps ASAP.

As we proceed into March, let's remember the best way to get a man into the Knights is a face-to-face invitation. And the best time to extend this invitation is during one of your council events. When your council is performing a service for a man or his family is when he will see the most benefit of joining.
